I am currently in the process, with senior leaders, in setting the staffing structure for next year. Mrs Smart our Nursery teacher has successfully gained promotion and will be leaving us in July. We are so sad to see her go but delighted for her as she moves to a leadership role in Adamsdown Primary School in Cardiff. I am sure she will keep in touch, we all wish her well for the future.

I am delighted to announce that we will be creating a bespoke Early Years unit which will see Nursery and Reception learning in the wonderful current Nursery building. This change has been carefully considered in consultation with staff, Governors and parents due to changes in staff and falling birth rate, thinking about what's best for the children first and foremost, for financial security for staff, enhanced learning opportunities in line with the new curriculum and the best use of the bespoke buildings/resources. Moving the Reception team to work alongside the Nursery team, will form a dynamic Early Years team (EY). Mrs Owen will lead the EY team as a member of the senior leadership team and Mrs Jones would lead the Nursery as a Higher Level Teaching Assistant. Mrs Owen will lead on planning and assessment, and have the overall responsibility for Safeguarding and Health and Safety.

The forming of an Early Years Unit is an incredible opportunity, which we are very excited about and will enhance our curriculum. The Curriculum for Wales- Progression Step one is Nursery and Reception. (The first step on the continuum of learning) Certainly Estyn, (The school's inspectorate in Wales) would judge this an excellent practice. All practical issues such as Breakfast club, lunches etc. can be solved quite easily and Reception would still be part of whole school activities and events.

Our community picnic, celebrating families is planned for Friday 28th June, all are welcome. Please bring a picnic and a rug and join us.

Our June school value is 'Changes', and our assemblies will be focusing on thoughtfulness. Our Rights of the child focus is, 'To be the best you can be!'. We will be talking to the children about the positive changes ahead. Mrs Karakus, our school cook is certainly leading the way-please see over. She has won the School Chef of the Year Wales 2024. She is now going to compete in the National competition- we wish her good luck!
